Have You Been Taking Your Cans to the Recycle Center – If not read below about our “CAN DAY”

“YES WE CAN! City Mayors Cash for Cans annual aluminum beverage can recycling contest, called “YES WE CAN!”. This program supports our efforts to be a “green” school and may bring in a grand prize of \$1,250. Aluminum cans will be collected from **October 1st thru October 31st**. The last day to collect cans is October 31, please drop your cans off on that day if you have not taken them to the recycle center or school. To drop your cans at school please

place them in the old blue "Rosie" bins next to the shed or by the flag pole. If you would like to take them directly to the recycling center you may drop your cans at Baker Iron and Metal on North Lime Street, Wise Recycling on Old Frankfort Pike or Harry Gordon Steel Company on Patterson Street. Please tell the recycling personnel our school name so that Providence will get "credit" for your cans. **Recycled can money is used for our pet care fund.**

The three individual schools that collect and recycle the most cans per capita will each receive \$1250. The three next highest schools receive \$1000 and the three next highest schools will receive \$750 each. The recycling companies will "pay" for all of our recycled cans at the end of October. This is a great opportunity for our school. Please help!
