Providence received a \$2,500.00 Neighborhood and Community Sustainability Grant from the city of Lexington. Bill Esarey, Landscape Architect, will attend the news conference held with Mayor Jim Newberry on Friday, April 23rd and receive the award on our behalf. The grant will be used to purchase native plantings for a rain garden which is part of the Phase One Campus Master Plan.

Providence will once again offer its popular summer camps for primary and lower elementary students. The dates for 2010 are June 7 - July 30.
