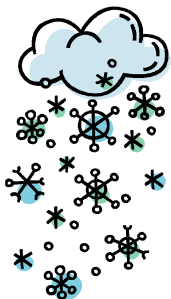
DID YOU KNOW???... Providence Classrooms are helping others in the community through community service projects for the Holiday Seasons:
