**It's that time of year again.... A reminder about our illness/sick policy:** We follow the National Health & Safety Performance Standards, which states that your child should be kept home for at least 24 hours *after* the last occurrence of a fever (without medication such as Tylenol or Motrin), diarrhea, or vomiting. If your child has a communicable diseases or condition such as: Diarrhea, Vomiting, Conjunctivitis (pink eye), Mouth sores, Impetigo, Strep throat, Scabies, Skin rashes (not diaper) s/he should be kept at home for 24 hours after the first dose of antibiotics, or until your doctor has given a written statement that your child may return to school.
